The Ace Bailey Children's Foundation Got Skills Competition ("GOT SKILLS") is a top shelf youth ice hockey skills competition. Supported by the NHL, this grass roots, youth hockey program showcases the glory of the human spirit both on the ice and through our charitable partnership with the Ace Bailey Children's Foundation. GOT SKILLS is the ultimate skills challenge for Squirt aged (9-10) and Pee Wee aged (11-12) youth ice hockey players.

It is a place for them to test their skills against their peers across the country in a variety of skills categories- fastest skater, best puck handler, hardest shot, shooting accuracy, best goalie. All tournaments take place in local rinks across the US. Local category winners advance to tougher competition in regional playoffs and the national finals.

The Ace Bailey Children's Foundation Got Skills Competition ("GOT SKILLS") was established in memory of Garnet "Ace" Bailey who was the Director of Scouting for the Los Angeles Kings when his flight, United flight #175 from Boston to Los Angeles, struck the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001.
